

Requests and Commitments per Student

To follow up the report of Funding Year 2007 Requests per Student, Funds For Learning provides this analysis of Funding Year 2006 Requests and Commitments per Student. This report provides information for the amount of E-rate requests and commitments per student by state. It is divided into two sections, one for Priority One services and one for Priority Two services.

Statewide student counts provided by the US Department of Education National Center for Education Statistics was used in calculating the per student amounts found in this report. Funds For Learning's E-rate Manager EDGE was used as the source for E-rate funding request and commitment information.

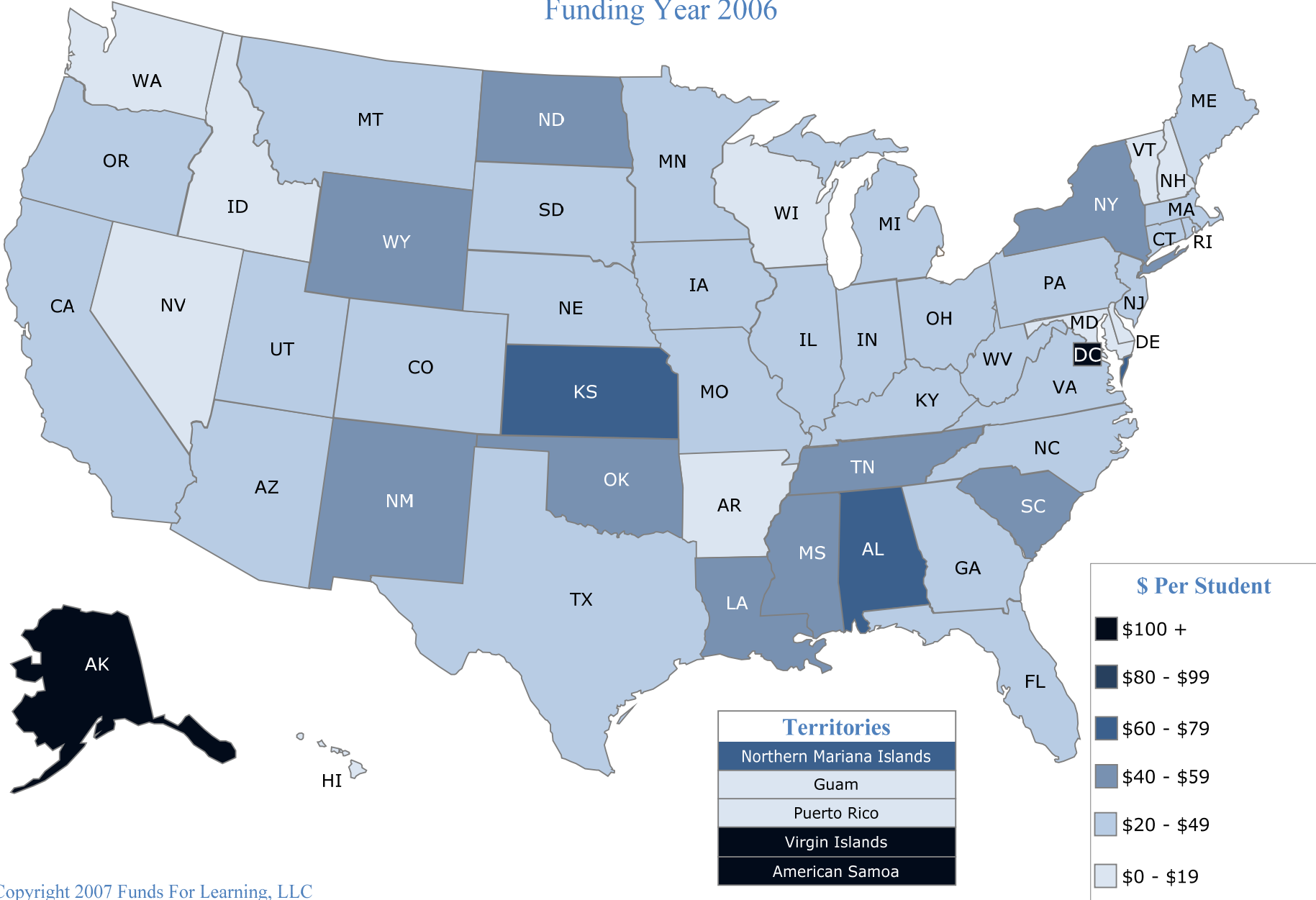
The data is divided into two sections. The first section reports the Priority One requested dollars per student for each state and territory in which schools or districts applied for E-rate discounts. Priority One requests fall into the Telecommunications Services and Internet Access categories of service. The next section reports the same information for the Priority Two services of Internal Connections and Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections.

In the calculation of Priority Two requests and commitments per student, E-rate funding requests featuring discount rates at or below 84% were not included in the analysis. These funding requests fall below the Priority Two discount threshold established by the Federal Communications Commission for Funding Year 2006.

Priority One Committed Dollars Per Student Funding Year 2006



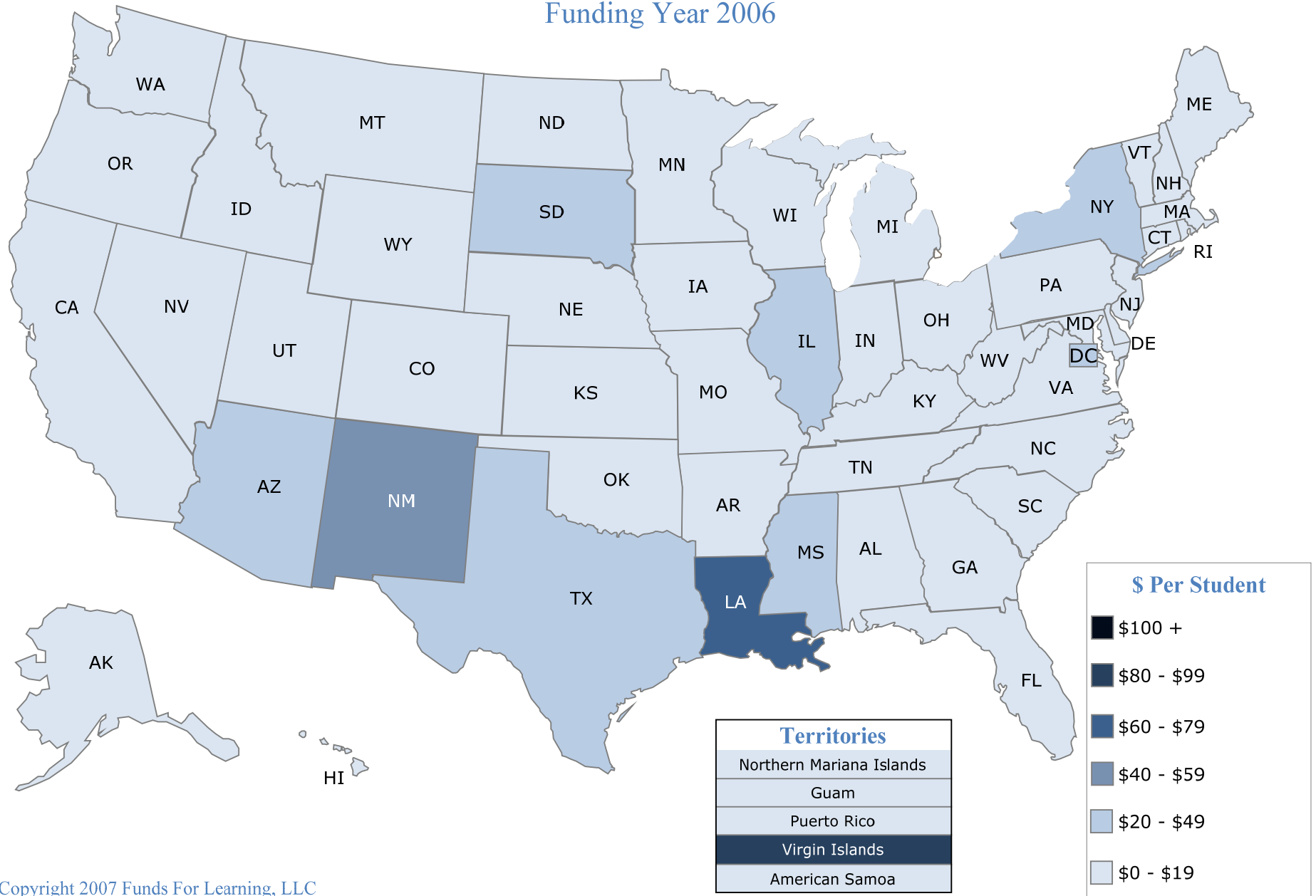
