**CHAIRMAN PAI TO VISIT AREAS IMPACTED BY  
HURRICANE HARVEY NEXT TUESDAY**

WASHINGTON, August 30, 2017—The Federal Communications Commission announced today that on Tuesday, September 5, Chairman Ajit Pai will be in Texas to inspect the damage caused by Hurricane Harvey and meet with those engaged in recovery efforts.

“Working in close coordination with the Department of Homeland Security, the FCC will do everything it can to help restore communications services after this terrible storm,” said Chairman Pai. “I look forward to meeting those on the ground in Texas and seeing firsthand what needs to be done to make sure that those affected can get back on their feet as quickly as possible.”
