Current Eligible Services List

Infinity feels strongly that the current version of the Eligible Services List (ESL) is

sufficient to provide anchor institutions with necessary network infrastructure to provide access

to the internet. We do recognize that firewalls are covered by the ESL, but only in part and

submittals require cost allocation for services necessary for operation. Infinity believes that all

aspects of the firewall, including software associated with the firewall, should be allowed as an

E-Rate expense.

Additions to the Eligible Services List

Infinity believes that anchor institutions have a legal, moral and ethical obligation to

protect the information that is required to be collected on its students, staff members, and

patrons. It is not enough to simply provide technology rich resources to our student-

stakeholders. We must protect our students and patrons, their information, and the resources we

provide them to learn. The current trend of anchor institutions having sensitive information

seized by nefarious acts brings to light the need for increased network security. We feel that the

following should be added to the Eligible Services List in an effort to assist anchor institutions in

their effort to secure confidential information. Cybersecurity solutions that are included but are

not limited to are Endpoint Protection, Advanced Threat Detection, Cybersecurity Assessment

and Threat Intelligence.
